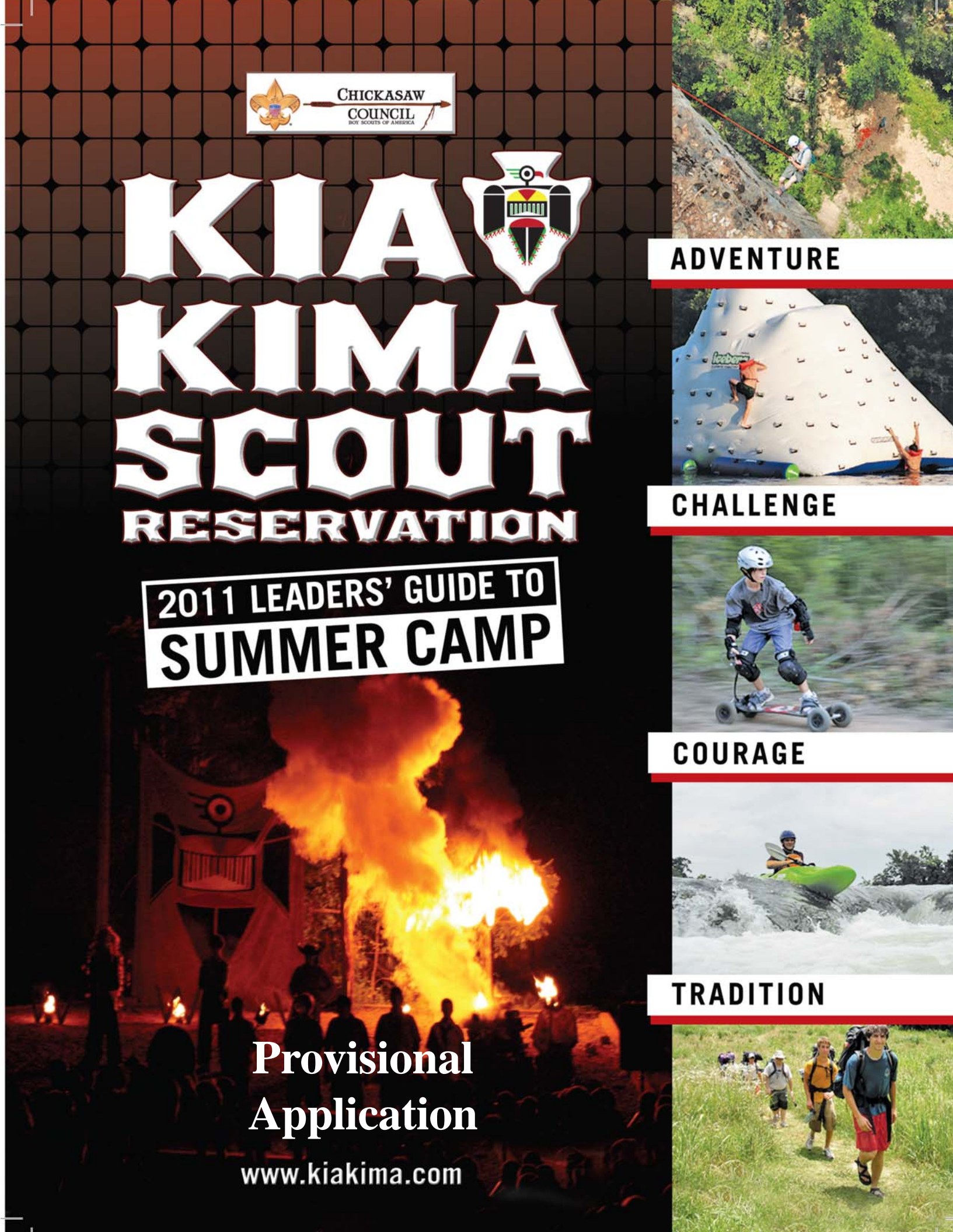

## This Guide

This Guide will allow a Scout who is not attending camp with his regular Troop to have the opportunity to attend. Leadership will be provided in these provisional units. Scouts are responsible for their own transportation to and from camp. Individual Scouts should plan to arrive between 1:00 PM and 3:00 PM on the Sunday beginning his chosen week.. We will have your paperwork on file but you should bring extra copies just in case. Use the Merit Badge Schedule on the opposite page to select which programs you wish to participate in. Transfer the corresponding classes to the registration section on the oapplication included in this packet.

## Housing & Accomodations

All Scouts attending as provisionals will be housed at Camp Osage in two man wall tents with cots. Meals will be served in the dining hall.
